Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy governs the manner in which "Site" collects, uses, maintains, and discloses information collected from users (each, a "User") of the website ("Site"). This statement governs our privacy policies with respect to those Users of the Site who visit without transacting business and Users who register to transact business on the Site and make use of the various products and services offered by GTEH Homes, LLC (herein referred to as "Company").

“Personally Identifiable Information” ("PII") refers to any information that identifies or can be used to identify, contact, or locate the person to whom such information pertains, including, but not limited to, name, address, phone number, email address, social security number, and credit card information. PII does not include information that is collected anonymously (that is, without identification of the individual user) or demographic information not connected to an identified individual.

We may collect PII from Users in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, when Users visit our site, fill out a form, register on the site, place an order, respond to a survey, and in connection with other activities, services, features, or resources we make available on our Site. Users may be asked for, as appropriate, name, email address, phone number.

However, Users may also visit our Site anonymously. We will collect personal identification information from Users only if they voluntarily submit such information to us. Users can always refuse to supply PII, although that it may prevent them from engaging in and accessing certain Site-related activities and features and from purchasing products and services offered on the Site.

We may collect non-personal identification information about Users whenever they interact with our Site. Non-personal identification information may include the browser name, the type of computer and technical information about Users means of connection to our Site, such as the operating system and the Internet service providers utilized and other similar information.

How does the Site use PII?

We use PII to customize and personalize the Site, to perform services Users requested, to send Users information they agreed to receive about topics we think will be of interest to them, to make appropriate product and service offerings, and to improve our Site and provide customer service.

Who is the information shared with?

We do not sell, trade, or rent Users personal identification information to others. We may share generic, aggregated demographic information not linked to any PII regarding visitors and users with our business partners, trusted affiliates, and advertisers for the purposes

outlined above. We may also use third party service providers, vendors, subsidiaries, affiliates, successor in interest, or subcontractors to help us operate our business and the Site or administer activities on our behalf, such as sending out newsletters or surveys. In order to use this website, a user may be required to first complete a registration form. During registration a user is required to give certain information (such as name and email address). This information is used to contact you about the products/services on our site in which you have expressed interest. At your option, you may also provide demographic information (such as gender or age) about yourself, but it is not required.

How is Personally Identifiable Information stored?

Personally Identifiable Information collected by the Company is securely stored and is not accessible to third parties or employees of the Company except for use as indicated above. We adopt appropriate data collection, storage and processing practices and security measures to protect against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure or destruction of your personal information, username, password, transaction information and data stored on our Site. We take precautions to protect your information. When you submit sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline. Wherever we collect sensitive information (such as credit card data), that information is encrypted and transmitted to us in a secure way. You can verify this by looking for a lock icon in the address bar and looking for "https" at the beginning of the address of the Web page. While we use encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online, we also protect your information offline. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, billing or customer service) are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers/servers in which we store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.

How long will Personally Identifiable Information stored?

Information may be stored indefinitely until User asks for it to be deleted.

User Rights

Users have the right to request access, rectification, and erasure or the 'right to be forgotten' of PII. Users have the right to withdraw consent for data processing at any time by emailing tanya@tanyaehood.com. We will not require you to provide any data beyond what is required for the purposes of completing a contract.

What choices are available to Visitors regarding collection, use and distribution of the information?

We may use the email address to send User information and updates pertaining to their order. It may also be used to respond to their inquiries, questions, and/or other requests. If User decides to opt-in to our mailing list, they will receive emails that may include company news, updates, related product or service information, etc. Users may opt-out of receiving unsolicited information from or being contacted by us and/or our vendors and affiliated agencies by unsubscribing from our email list as instructed at the bottom of each email.

Are Cookies Used on the Site?

Cookies may be used on our Site for a variety of reasons. We use Cookies to obtain information about the preferences of our Users and the products and services they select. User's web browser places cookies on their hard drive for record-keeping purposes and sometimes to track information about them. Users may choose to set their web browser to refuse cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If they do so, note that some parts of the Site may not function properly.

Third Party Websites and Affiliate Programs

Users may find advertising, links to affiliate programs, and other content on our Site that link to the sites and services of our partners, suppliers, advertisers, sponsors, licensors, and other third parties. We do not control the content or links that appear on these sites and are not responsible for the practices employed by websites linked to or from our Site.

Additionally, these sites, products, and services, including their content and links, may change at any time. These sites, products, and services may have their own privacy policies and customer service policies. Browsing and interaction on any other website, including websites which have a link to our Site, is subject to that website's own terms and policies.

Surveys and Contests

From time-to-time our site requests information via surveys or contests. Participation in these surveys or contests is completely voluntary and you may choose whether or not to participate and therefore disclose this information. Information requested may include contact information (such as name and shipping address), and demographic information (such as zip code, age level). Contact information will be used to notify the winners and award prizes and to inform all participants of future surveys and contests. Survey information will be used for purposes of monitoring or improving the use and satisfaction of this site.

What happens if the Privacy Policy Changes?

This Site has the discretion to update this privacy policy at any time. We will let our Users know about changes to our privacy policy by posting such changes on the Site.
